

Messy Church RWB

Messy Church is a form of church for all ages, children and adults, which involves creativity, celebration and hospitality. It's fun, welcoming and inclusive. It's a church for people at all stages of their faith journey and primarily for people who don't already belong to another form of church. The whole of Messy Church is about worshipping God, introducing Jesus, having fellowship and exploring faith matters. It welcomes everyone, involves everyone, values everyone, is always there for the outsider. It can be messy and it's a church.

Messy Church RWB meets at RWBMC on the third Saturday of every month except December and August. The 'congregation' comes along from 10.30am till around 12.30pm. We currently have a total team membership of 15. Between 9 and 13 team members come along once a month from 9.30am till 1/1.30pm to support with creativity, celebration or hospitality.

Every Messy Church session has a time of chatting and creativity - several different types of crafting/making linked to a Bible theme are on offer, possibly involving biscuits or paper plates or paint or newspaper or glue or cut outs or construction kits. Celebration time can incorporate noise, peace, thinking, listening, reading, acting, music. During hospitality time we share a simple lunch together prepared by a wonderful catering team. Examples of lunch are jacket potatoes, pizza etc. and we aim to include a vegetarian option.

You can belong and be part of Messy Church RWB in so many different ways. Every contribution will be valued and make a difference as together we share God's story and Jesus.
